

## Career and Technical Education Course Code Changes

Course code changes in the May 2008 release of NCWISE include new Career and Technical Education course codes that minimize the need for use of generic codes to represent multiple courses. Use of the new codes is recommended but optional for 2008-2009. All schools must use the codes beginning with academic year 2009-2010.
