

Directions for assembling the NC K-2 Literacy folder

The NC K-2 Literacy folder is made up of 4 pages. You may cut and glue the pages to folders **or** the LEA can print the folder on card stock.

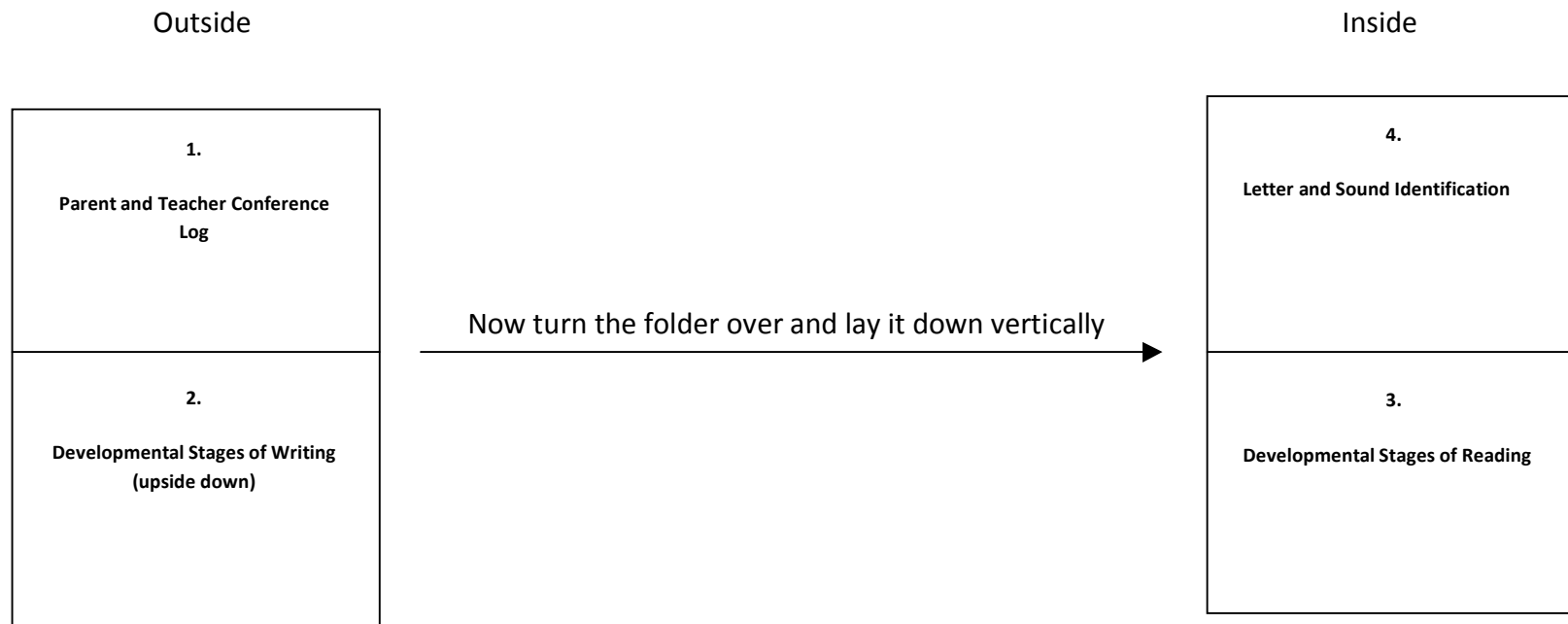
To cut and glue:

First, open up the folder so you are looking at what is the front and back of the folder. Lay the open folder down vertically.

Glue each page onto a folder as follows:

Page 1: Parent/Teacher Conference Log at the top of the open folder (this will be on the front/outside of the folder)

Page 2: Developmental Stages of Writing underneath the Parent/Teacher Conference Log **upside down** (this will be the back of the folder after it is folded.)



Page 3: Developmental Stages of Reading on the bottom of the inside of the folder

Page 4: Letter and Sound Identification-Primary Spelling Inventory above the Developmental Stages of Reading (on the top of the inside of the folder)

After the glue dries, fold it back into a folder and write the student's name on the tab. Double-sided tape is another option.
