FY 2010-2011 Planning Allotments for Federal Programs

Your Federal Program Planning Allotments for FY 2010-11 were uploaded March 30, 2010. To assist you in reviewing the federal allotments, a summary of the formulas used in planning will also be on our website at <http://www.ncpublicschools.org/fbs/allotments/planning/>.

In order to receive this anticipated funding, an application must be completed for each grant by the required due date. Please contact the federal program consultants at the Department for current application due dates.

The Federal Planning Allotments do not include the following formula grants:

PRC 048 – Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities – Not funded in FY 10-11.

PRC 107 – Educational Technology- Formula – In the past a percentage of the Educational Technology was allotted based on formula and the remaining competitively. In FY 10-11, 100% of this grant will be allocated in PRC 108 – Educational Technology – Competitive.

Please remember that only carryover will be available for all of the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) grants for FY 10-11, including PRC 140 – Federal State Stabilization.

These federal planning allotments are based on the most recent information received from Washington, DC. **Please remember that planning allotments are subject to change.**
