Laptops may be checked out from Central Services. Provide training in reflective writing. Maintain contact with the North Carolina Association Educators, Department of Public Instruction and other resources to share information with applicants. Ask principals to provide access to a video camera, video duplication equipment and laptop computers. Video cameras may be checked out from Central Services. Help to establish a network contact with appropriate grade or subject teachers who recently completed the National Board certification process. Provide access to copying equipment. Recognize successful completers.
