The U.S. Department of Education issued a new resource, [Transitioning to the Every Student Succeeds Act \(ESSA\)](#) on February 26, 2016. The document offers guidance to states during the transition from the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to ESSA by responding to Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs).

TITLE III JOINS CCIP

We are pleased to announce that, beginning 2016-2017, the Title III Application will be part of the consolidated application in the web-based grants management system, the Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan (CCIP). This move allows the Department of Public Instruction to streamline the application process and to build capacity to serve English learners (ELs) through collaboration.
